Eligibility

- ~ All work must be based on the theme of WATER and/or SUSTAINABILITY.
- ~ All media accepted.
- ~ Work must not exceed 30 lbs.
- ~ Work must be ready to be displayed upon arrival.
- ~ Work must have been created within the last three years.

Region

All artists who apply must live in Texas or states bordering Texas

All images must be submitted online through CaFE at www.callforentry.org and must follow the requirements set by CaFE.

Entry Fee

\$15 for 1 image and \$5 for each additional image. Video and audio must be sent to Richland. All proceeds to benefit RLC Scholarships.
